

Fund Overview

The Fund's primary investment objective is to achieve 3 times (300%) the income generated from selling options on Nasdaq-100 Index. (NASDAQ QQQ) (the "Underlying Stock") by selling options on leveraged exchange-traded funds designed to deliver 3 times (300%) the daily performance of the Underlying Stock (the "Underlying Leveraged ETF"). The Fund's secondary investment objective is to gain exposure to the performance of the Underlying Leveraged ETF, subject to a cap on potential investment gains. A downside protection may be implemented which could affect the net income level.

During the period of June 30, 2025 to June 30, 2026, the Fund had a 11.29% return.

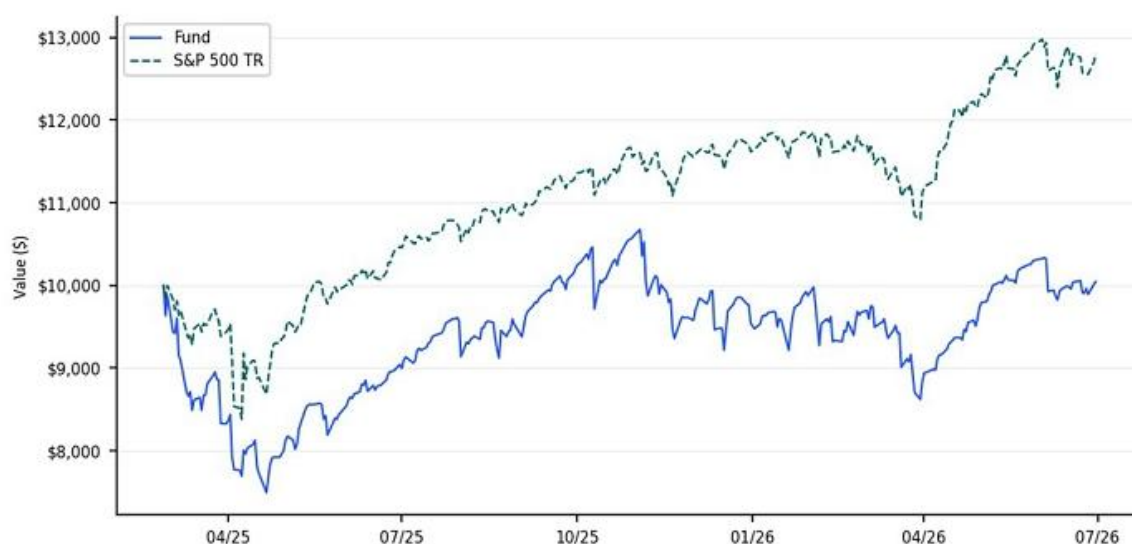
Over the same period the Benchmark had a return of 22.32%.

What does the Fund invest in?

The Fund sells put options contracts, either directly or through swap contracts, on the ProShares UltraPro[®] QQQ (NASDAQ: TQQQ), for which it will receive a premium. The put options contracts sold by the Fund may vary in regard to their strike prices and their maturity from 1-week to 1-month.

The Fund may also invest in (1) U.S. Government securities, such as bills, notes and bonds issued by the U.S. Treasury; (2) money market funds; (3) short term bond ETFs and/or (4) corporate debt securities, such as commercial paper and other short-term unsecured promissory notes issued by businesses that are rated investment grade or of comparable quality as collateral for the Fund's swap agreements
